



Guidelines for taking a Hay or Haylage Sample

It is advisable to use the correct method when taking a silage sample as any analytical result is only as good as the sample taken.

- Different cuttings or lots should be analysed separately.
- Take a handful from a number of bales (at least 5).
- Combine the samples and submit as one sample for analysis.
- The sample should weigh around 100g.
- Clearly label the sample with date, time and reference.
- Include your contact details with the delivered sample.
